Department for Education Funding for NPQs in Sefton

Ten million pounds is available to support teachers and leaders working in category 5 and category 6 areas to take the new NPQs. This funding will cover full course costs, and all teachers and leaders in these areas are eligible for this funding.

The funding will be for participants who:

- are working in a school in an Opportunity Area or a Category 5 or 6 area
- do not already hold the NPQ for which they are applying, and have not previously dropped out before completing the NPQ for which they are applying
