



Welcome to Greenbank

One of the highlights in preparing for transition to secondary school is the new school uniform.

Our Uniform

- Compulsory grey blazer with green trim and green school badge.
- Dark green 'A' line or pleated skirt or pinafore dress of a modest length.
- Dark green tailored trousers.
- Green and white striped blouse with a flat collar.
- Plain grey or green knee-length socks. If tights are worn they must be grey or black.
- Shoes must be all black. Any logos must be covered or removed.
- Optional Dark green v-necked pullover/cardigan with school logo.
- A plain dark coat or jacket.
- Hair bands, bobbles (which are needed to tie hair back in practical subjects) or head scarves should be black or green.



For Physical Education

- White sports shirt with green trim, Greenbank badge and initials.
- Black skorts or shorts with green and white trim (for all activities).
- Black with green and white trim hooded sweatshirt with Greenbank badge.
- Black track pants (optional to be used during the winter).
- Trainers.
- $\frac{3}{4}$ length white sports socks.
- We recommend shin pads and a gum shield for hockey.
- No jewellery should be worn on PE days in the interest of health and safety.



All articles of clothing must be named with sewn-in labels or permanent marker.

Kit should be kept in a large drawstring bag, also named. Other open type bags are inadequate and may lead to kit being lost. Only this bag should be taken to PE lessons.

How to Purchase School Uniform

Option 1

Place your order online – www.whittakersschoolwear.co.uk (**vouchers cannot be used online**)

Ordering your uniform online means that you don't have to leave your home. On their website you will need to click on the SHOP tab, then click on Southport, and locate Greenbank school uniform.

Please try to order as soon as possible, to avoid not having your uniform in time for the start of term in September.

Option 2

Make an appointment with Whittakers to shop in store, at **35/39 London Street, PR9 0UY**.

To ensure the safety of staff and customers through social distancing, they will be operating a strict appointment only service in the shop. This means that we will not be allowing customers' entry to the shop unless a prior appointment has been made.

You will be able to make your appointment from **22/06/2020** by downloading the Booksy app (available through app stores on both Apple and Android phones) and searching **Whittakers Schoolwear.co.uk Southport** or you can visit www.whittakersschoolwear.co.uk and click on the BOOK APPT tab.

If you would like to visit their shop, please make your appointment as soon as you can after 22/06/2020. They will have extended opening hours over the summer including evenings and Sundays. If you find that all appointments have been taken, and the shop is fully booked, you will have no option but to order your uniform online. Anyone who turns up to the shop without an appointment will be turned away.
