
## **Behaviour for Learning: Sanctions process**

Where a pupil's behaviour falls below the expectations, sanctions will be put in place to help that pupil learn from their mistakes. If unacceptable behaviour is repeated the sanctions will gradually increase, which is called a graduated response, to ensure there is a sustained improvement.





## Low level behaviours

Behaviour points can be accumulated during the day, with some adaptations made for our young carers and SEND pupils which would be communicated with staff when required, before the relevant sanction(s) are issued.

#### IS one day sanctions (4 points)

- Anti-social behaviour
- Discriminatory behaviour
- Intimidation
- Misuse of CCTV
- Repeated Level 3 behaviour breach
- Serious misuse of social media e.g. in-school filming
- Truancy from school (parental meeting)
- Graffiti

### IS two day sanctions (5 points)

- Act of aggression
- Bullying
- Intentional damage to property
- Stealina
- Intimidation of a staff member
- Misuse of fire alarm
- Swearing at staff
- · Smoking or vaping

### Suspension (5 points)

- Alcohol or substance misuse
- Continuous breaking of behaviour system
- Prejudice with intent to sabotage reputation
- Bringing the school into disrepute serious
- Serious social media misuse which attempts to damage reputation
- High level act of aggression or aggressive confrontation
- · High level theft or stealing

# **Higher level behaviours** (continued...)

### Truancy



This will be dealt with through a different sanctioning system, with truancy from form and lessons both treated at the same level.

The only exception, to above, is truancy from school.

Below is an outline of the process to be followed, if truancy occurs.

Pupil truants PDT and/or lesson(s)

Process to be repeated for repeat offenders

Pupil placed in isolation by SLT or behaviour lead

Parental meeting(s) with Mrs Robinson/SLT and pastoral member of staff

Pupil to remain in isolation

Parents invited in to sign truancy agreement
