Sefton schools - #kNOwKnifeCrime Initiative

Your child has volunteered and been selected to participate in the school-to-school relay event on Wednesday 17th April to spread the message of #kNOwknifecrime.

On Wednesday 17th April, runners from Greenbank High School will run two legs. The first leg will start at 11.55am from Lord Street and back to Greenbank. Pupils on this leg will catch the train from Hillside to Southport with a member of staff, then walk to Lord Street. The second leg will start at 1.05pm from Greenbank High to Birkdale High and back - hopefully without any rainfall!

We will be raising money for the purchase of bleeding control kits and cabinet which will be fixed on the outside of our school. A bleeding control kit can help provide support for the bleeding caused by knife injuries to make the difference for a victim to survive an attack. The kits were developed by the Major Trauma Centre at Aintree University Hospital. The aim of the fundraising is to ensure that there are bleeding control kits in as many locations as possible throughout the Borough. 84 schools in Sefton are participating in this event.
