

World Book Week plan 2025 (w/b 3rd March 2025)

Monday 3rd	<u>Spot the Book</u> – staff to bring in their favourite book or print a poster of it and hide it in plain sight, either within their room or on their person. Worksheets and prizes for the most spotted.
Tuesday 4th	<u>The Greenbank Book Hunt</u> – After school treasure hunt with children signing up to take part, meeting in the library and then winning sweets or book related prizes! (KS3)
Wednesday 5th	<u>The Big Book Quiz</u> – PDT time book quiz to be completed by all years with the winning form receiving a prize for PDT on the Friday.
Thursday 6th	<u>World Book Day</u> – Staff and student prizes. Masked Reader Quiz in Key Stage 3 English. World Book Day assembly for PDT. Poetry quiz KS4.
Friday 7th	Results of competitions from throughout the week and presentation of prizes to winners. DEAR in non-practical subjects (15 mins of reading a book/ extract that you enjoy and would like to share with the pupils).

In conjunction with this:

- WBD assemblies run by Literacy Leaders (Mon, Tue and Wed)
- Book review competition (all years – beginning after half term!)
- Design your own book token competition (running throughout World Book Week)
- "Where's Wally" competition.
- "Guess who's coming to tea" activity in the library - guess the character based on the props!
